Project Summary

PS Energy Group, which operates four fueling stations or Unattended Fuel Outlet (UFO) locations in metro Atlanta, will add CNG facilities at its East Point, Lithonia and Tucker, Ga. sites and expand the dispensing capacity of CNG at its downtown Atlanta site on Whitehall Street. The computerized fueling stations are open year-round, 24 hours a day and are easily accessible to individuals and commercial and municipal fleets.

Why it is important

Involvement in the Clean Cities Atlanta Petroleum Reduction Program is yet another example of PS Energy Group's long-term commitment to help increase energy efficiency while enhancing the quality of our environment.

PS Energy Group became one of the first certified marketers of Georgia's deregulated natural gas program in 1989, and in 1993, established the fueling station at Whitehall Street in downtown Atlanta that includes CNG for commercial and municipal fleets. Today, anyone with a PS Energy Group UFO Going Green account can use the Whitehall UFO with a specially issued card to fill up vehicles with alternative fuels such as CNG and E85.

Expansion of PS Energy's capability to offer CNG at its strategically located UFOs along the U.S. Interstate 85 corridor will encourage individuals and fleets to replace an estimated 270,000 gallons a month of petroleum with cleaner alternative fuels.
