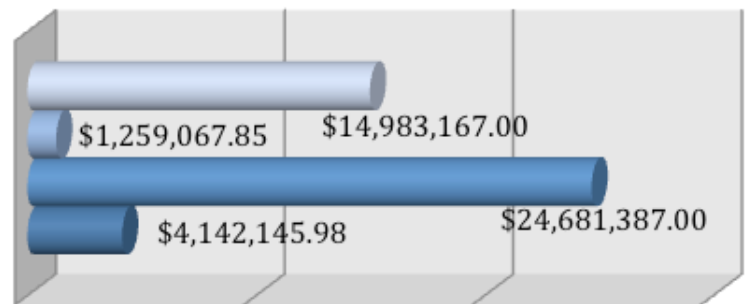

### PS Energy Makes Progress on CNG Stations

During this quarter, PS Energy competed vendor selection and contracting for their new CNG Stations. In addition to this contracting, all land disturbance permits have been obtained and all of the necessary building permits will be in effect by the end of 2nd Quarter 2011. As of the first week of April, all equipment was ordered for these stations.

### Coca-Cola Trucks Operational

As of this quarter, all of the hybrid trucks purchased through this project were licensed and placed into route operations. Now the fuel consumed and miles traveled for each truck deployed on beverage delivery route operations are being tracked. Plans have also been made for Coca-Cola Refreshments to participate in a Clean Cities Public Relations Media Event next quarter at the Clean Energy Fueling Station.

### The Parking Spot to Deploy 20 Project Vehicles

The Parking Spot will receive and deploy 20 new CNG vehicles by the end of April. These shuttle vehicles will shuttle passengers between Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport and The Parking Spot airport parking facilities.
